<p>Explanation of indicated content</p> <p>Prohibited</p> <p>In addition to the listed items, the followings are also prohibited to import:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Soil (including plants with soil)- Parasite plants (e.g. Loranthaceae, Cassytha sp., Rafflesia sp., Cuscuta sp., Pedicularis sp. and Orobanchaceae) <p>Requiring ordinary inspection</p> <p>The listed plants can be imported with ordinary import inspection as far as certain conditions are met. Examples of the conditions are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Attachment of the appropriate Phytosanitary Certificate(issued by the plant quarantine authority of the country of origin)- Limitation of places where the articles are unloaded and imported- Successful results of inspection conducted by the Plant Protection Station
